## About Soi Dog Foundation:

Soi Dog Foundation is the largest animal welfare organisation in Asia dedicated to helping stray dogs and cats. Soi Dog Foundation sterilises, vaccinates, administers medical treatment, shelters, promotes adoption of stray dogs and cats in Thailand, and runs education programmes on animal welfare. Soi Dog Foundation is also actively working to end South East Asia's dog meat trade, and is expanding within South East Asia, having recently opened an operation in Vietnam.

Soi Dog's Mission Statement is: **"To improve the welfare of dogs and cats in Asia, resulting in better lives for both the animal and human communities, to create a society without homeless animals, and to ultimately end animal cruelty"**. Its core values are compassion, honesty, integrity and transparency.

## JOB DESCRIPTION

**Job Title and Summary:** Veterinarian (Bangkok Mobile) position will perform both sterilization, surgery at our mobile spay/neuter clinics, ancillary soft-tissue procedures, treat sick and injured dogs and cats, communicate with the public.

**Key Responsibilities:** The staff veterinarian is responsible for performing all medical diagnostics and treatments, in accordance with the standards and policies set by Soi Dog Foundation, contributing to high quality animal care. This key staff member performs surgical procedures, maintains medical records, and manages medical cases.

### Essential Job Duties:

- Diagnose and treat sick and injured cats and dogs presenting to the shelter
- Perform up to 20 sterilization procedures daily
- Administer treatments (injections, CPR, oral medications, fluid therapy, wound dressings, first aid)
- Maintain up to date and accurate electronic medical records
- Perform routine bloodwork (CBC/chemistry), urinalyses, and skin scrapes
- Communicate with owners and feeders
- Perform euthanasia and abortions when warranted
- Dispense drugs in accordance with hospital rules
- Liaise with the Shelter Manager regarding animal disposition
- Participate in mobile sterilization clinics
- Manage emergency cases as they present to the clinic
- As part of the Soi Dog team, be available to help as needed, even with tasks that are outside of the job description

**Department and Supervisor:** The position will be a part of Animal Welfare team and report to Bangkok Animal Welfare Director

**Skills and Qualifications:**

- Male or Female Thai nationality
- Fair English communication skills and work well with a diverse staff
- Must have a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree and valid license to practice veterinary medicine.
- Wiling to train in high-quality, high-volume spay/neuter techniques if needed.

**Location:** Bangkok

**Type of Employment:** The role of veterinarian is a full time position.
